Covid Vaccinations – 10th March 2022

- Following our announcement in the Parent Bulletin on the 17th January we can now advise that the school-based Immunisation Team are attending Biddick Academy on **10th March 2022** to administer the second dose of the Covid vaccination for children aged 12-15 years; inclusive of all 12-year old's and 15-year old's who may have not had first dose or require a second.
- Only children who have returned the consent form by the deadline of 17th January 2022 will be vaccinated and the Immunisation Team are unable to accept late consent forms.
