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## WHAT DO I NEED TO KNOW THIS WEEK?

#### Dear Parent/Carer.

It has been a pleasure to welcome back our students this week. I would like to thank all students, staff and parents for their fantastic support and cooperation in embracing and respecting significant changes to normal ways of working. I have spent the first full week of term assessing the measures that we have put in place to ensure that students and staff alike can study and work in a safe, clean, calm and ordered environment. I am satisfied that these measures are working and I am exceptionally impressed at the maturity of our students who are following new expectations, such as regular hand washing and adhering to one-way systems seriously.

### Arriving/Leaving School

This term poses unique challenges due to COVID-19, remember that it is preferable for students to walk or cycle to school rather than arriving by car or bus. This is the safest option for their health and also helps us to reduce congestion in the car park. If your son/daughter must travel to school by public transport, they should wear a face covering and comply with social distancing wherever they can. Furthermore, we are encouraging students to wear a face mask when moving to and from year group zones in school.

### **Attendance**

Attendance has been excellent so far this term and we hope that this continues. However, if your child does experience any of the following symptoms: a new, continuous cough, a high temperature or a loss of taste/smell, they should isolate at home and seek a Coronavirus test. Thank you for keeping us informed if this is the case.

### **Parent Meetings**

At the present time, 'drop-in' visits to the Academy are not permitted due to health and safety. If you need to speak to a member of staff, please telephone and if necessary, an appointment can be arranged. These arrangements are in place to protect the health and safety of everyone in the Biddick Academy community. I'm sure you will have read about the increase in local cases and support us in taking every precaution to prevent the transmission of Coronavirus in school.

### Parents' Evenings

We are currently putting in place alternative provision to replace our usual parents' evenings. Further details will follow in due course.

#### After School Learning

I have been very impressed by the eagerness that the students are showing when it comes to their learning. We are acutely aware that your child's education must now be enhanced in order to make up for any gaps that may have occurred over 'lockdown'.
