WHAT DO I NEED TO KNOW?

School Meals

- Due to COVID-19 restrictions, school meals must be pre-ordered. Students can bring a packed lunch and snacks.

- 3. We automatically add daily Free School Meal allowances (£2.30 a day) to ParentPay using the information we receive from the Local Authority. If your child receives Free School Meals you will still need to place an order for a meal.

Remote Learning

- As mentioned in the letter from Miss Morris last week, if your child has to self-isolate, they will be able to access all of their usual lessons via our online platform Microsoft Teams. Teachers will livestream their lessons, so that your child can follow their normal timetable online.
- Students will be able to ask questions during the lesson using the 'chat' facility and upload their work to Teams for the teacher to assess.
- The lesson resources will be uploaded to Teams so that they can be used at a later date if your child is unable to join the Teams lesson live.

- As you are aware Biddick Academy has a 'staggered start' at the beginning of each day to allow all students to enter the Academy safely.
- Up until this point, the arrival time for our Year 8 cohort has been 8.50am. However after half term, week beginning <u>Monday 2nd November the new arrival time for Year 8 students has</u> <u>been brought forward to 8.40am.</u>
