ACADEMY INFORMATION - FOR ALL PARENTS/CARERS

School Meals

- > Due to COVID-19 restrictions, schools meals must be pre-ordered. Students can bring a packed lunch and snacks.
 - 1. Click on the following link to order a school lunch online. The link can be found on our website under Parents/News Events.

 - **DEADLINE** Thursday 8th October 2020 at 9.00am.
 - We have extended the deadline to allow more time to order.
 - 2. Access the following link to log onto your ParentPay account to ensure there are sufficient funds for us to take payment once your child has had the school lunch. https://www.parentpay.com/parents
 - 3. We automatically add daily Free School Meal allowances (£2.30 a day) to ParentPay using the information we receive from the Local Authority. If your child receives Free School Meals you will still need to place an order for a meal.
 - 4. If you are unable to access a device to place and online order, please contact us using the contact details at the end of this bulletin.

Face Masks
