Impact:

- The Academy's Curriculum Philosophy has been amended, with further social and emotional well-being aspects of school added.
- An assembly has been delivered to all year groups, encouraging awareness of personal development and giving ideas of avenues to explore.
- Students have interviewed parents with successful careers in the marine and pharmaceutical industries, asking questions about the pathways they took, deepening their understanding of local opportunities and creating potential future links between the Academy and local business.
