#### Year 10 Mock Examinations

- The Year 10 mock exams will commence on Monday 28th March.
- > The mock exams are vitally important as they allow students to demonstrate what they know and what they are capable of, as well as informing them and their teachers of their areas for development and improvement.

- If your child is entitled to access arrangements, Mrs Coats will contact to you in order to update you on the arrangements for these.
- As this is the first time that Year 10 students will have completed a full series of examinations in the Watson Hall, we have outlined some of the key points below many of which are regulations we must follow.
  - 1. If students are not timetabled to be in a mock exam, they attend their usual timetabled lesson.
  - 2. At the end of an exam, students return to their normal timetabled lesson.
  - 3. Students must arrive for all mock exams in the correct uniform.
  - 4. Students will be assigned a seat number for every exam.
  - 5. Students are not permitted to have their mobile phone in their possession during exams they must be switched off (not just on silent mode) and in their bags.
  - 6. Students are not permitted to wear a watch of any kind in examinations.
  - 7. Any additional resources such as water bottles and pencil cases must be clear and without labels.
