Congratulations to all of the students who were nominated – you should all be very proud of yourselves!



- In order to support your child with their Accelerated Reading and to delve deeper into their progress it is possible to login with your child to see their progress.
- If you login to Accelerated Reader through RM Unify with their details, you will be able to click on the Accelerated Reader orange tile. Within this you will find a section labelled 'Progress'. This details the amount of books your child has read as well as words to date. It also provides their information about their current level.
- Over the next few weeks your child will be completing their STAR Reading test so we can understand what their current reading level is.
