- Will my chosen subjects allow me to fulfil my educational and career aspirations?







Important Points to Note

- You must opt for a language to achieve the English Baccalaureate (Ebacc).
- You can only choose History AND Geography, Triple Science or Computer Science if you are in Pathway A.
- You can only choose French or Spanish if you have a minimum of a Grade 5 target in GCSE English.
- You are only allowed to select ONE Art discipline Art and Design, Digital Art, Fine Art or Textiles.
- Whilst every effort will be made to ensure that you receive your first-choice preferences where possible, it should be noted that this is not guaranteed and as such, you will select TWO 'Reserve' Options choices just in case allocation onto all courses of study are subject to popularity, teaching group sizes, staffing and minimum entry requirements.
