Uniform

- ➤ A gentle reminder that full school uniform must be worn at all times by pupils in Years 7 to 11.
- ➤ A high standard of presentation is expected of all pupils.
- The compulsory items of uniform that must be worn by all of our pupils are;
 - Biddick Academy blazer with school badge
 - Biddick Academy tie
 - A plain white school shirt, buttoned to the neck
 - Plain grey trousers to the ankle or Biddick Academy skirt.
- No hoodies or other tops, such as a tracksuit tops should be worn under the blazer, except Year 11 leavers hoodies.
- Leggings must not be worn.
- Footwear should be plain black leather or leather style shoes, plain black leather style trainer shoes are acceptable; however, they must be completely black leather. Suede and canvas shoes are not acceptable.
- We have strict rules regarding jewellery. One discreet stud in each ear is permitted, any other jewellery, including bracelets, rings will have to be removed. Body piecing is unacceptable, this incudes nose and tongue piercings. Pupils will be required to remove these.
- Pupils are not allowed to wear false nails of any kind, this includes gel or acrylic nails, no brightly coloured nail varnish is allowed.
- An appropriately sized school bag is a compulsory item of uniform; this means that every pupil should bring a school bag to school every day.
- ➤ If a pupil contravenes the uniform policy, then parents will be informed and asked to rectify the issue within 48 hours and the student will be loaned uniform from the Academy, which they will be expected to wear.
