- As part of our work to promote environmental awareness and sustainability amongst our pupils, Biddick Academy's Eco-Club have launched a school wide recycling initiative.
- The club are leading the way to minimise waste production within the Academy by implementing designated mixed recycling bins per year group for paper, plastic, glass, and other materials. Through regular waste audits and monitoring, progress will be tracked across the school and year groups who recycle the most each half term will be rewarded for their efforts.
